

**CENTRAL MASSACHUSETTS AGENCY ON AGING
TITLE III PROGRAMS FOR FY 2012**

Effective October 1, 2011, 27 grants in the amount of \$ 1,824,397 were awarded to 16 non-profit organizations serving elders throughout Central Massachusetts. These federal grants, authorized under the Older Americans Act, are targeted to meet the highest priority needs of persons 60 years of age and older.
